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Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of your child's English Literature GCSE in Y11, they will be assessed on Anthology poetry and unseen poetry. In the final exam, students must compare two pre-learned poems to one another, in addition to responding to, analysing, and comparing poems they have never read before.

In order to support the students' achievement, we would like to offer them the opportunity to experience poetry performed on stage, with a trip to Poetry Live! in Nottingham on 29th January 2024.

Poetry Live is a great event and some of the poets that student's study for their GCSE English Literature, such as the current Poet Laureate Simon Armitage, Carol-Ann Duffy, and John Agard, will perform their poetry and host workshops on their poems. The event will also be attended by two Chief Examiners of English Literature, who will give talks on skills that are vital for success in GCSE examinations.

We feel that this will be extremely beneficial for students, in addition to being an exciting and enjoyable trip to the theatre!

The day begins at 10:45am and we will leave school at 9am to get there in plenty of time. We will travel by coach. Students will be at the theatre until 3pm. Depending on traffic, we anticipate being back at school around 4:30pm. Parents/carers of students catching the school buses will need to make alternative arrangements for their child to get home after the event.

The cost of the trip is £26 which includes the event, and the travelling costs the Royal Concert Hall. An initial deposit of £10 will need to be paid to secure a place. Full payment must be made by Friday 20th October. We do appreciate that finances may be tight at the moment and that finding this may be difficult for some families, so please talk to Mrs Jones in Finance with any concerns.
