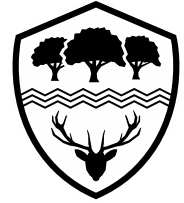

Meden Sports Day – Wednesday 10th July

Dear Parents/Carer,

Meden Sports Day will take place on Wednesday 10th July. All students and staff will be involved in the events from Period 4 and lunch times have been adapted to accommodate this. Students in Year 8 & 10 will have lunch at the earlier time of 11:25am with Year 7 & 9 students having lunch at 12:05pm.
