Over the next few weeks, your child will be considering their option choices for Year 10. They will be involved in various activities, outlined below, to help them make the best choices for them. These activities will culminate in an online Options Evening on Thursday 14th January, from 4pm until 9pm.

Activities over the coming weeks:

- An options booklet on making the right decisions, to be completed with tutors, during study periods
- All students have been given a log-on to UniFrog, an online destinations platform, where information can be found about all types of workplaces and careers
- One lesson will be spent in a computer suite, where students will access UniFrog
- Taster lessons, within departments, where students can experience what a KS4 lesson would be like in that subject
- Meetings and discussions with their tutor
- Meetings with Miss Wild or Mrs Brett for students who are struggling with their decisions

On the evening of January 14th, there will be videos available on the website, offering more information about the subjects at KS4. There is also a short presentation from me about the different things that you and your children may wish to consider.
