Homework is given as part of a 3 week cycle

1. Week 1 – create flashcards
2. Week 2 – look, say, cover, write check (using the flashcards created in week 1)
3. Week 3 – Brain dump - a check to see how much you have learned

The point of the homework is to teach students how to revise effectively and to build up key vocabulary for each of their core subjects.

Here is the work per subject for this 3 week cycle

ENGLISH – Learn the following key words

	Oppression	A person or group of people have power and use it in a way that is not fair, unjust or cruel.
	Fraternity	A group of people linked by common interests/ aims A brotherhood
	Novella	A short novel

SCIENCE – Learn the following key words

Practical Vocab	Random error	A difference in the results of an experiment caused by unpredictable events, e.g. human error in measuring.
	Systematic error	An error that is consistently made throughout an experiment.
	Zero error	A type of systematic error caused by using a piece of equipment that isn't zeroed properly.

MATHS – Learn the following key words

	Solve	Solve for x means finding the value of x for which the equation holds true. https://corbettmaths.com/2012/08/24/solving-equations/
	Inverse Operations	An inverse operation reverses a calculation that has been completed by using the opposite operation. Addition and subtraction are the inverse of each other. https://psn.virtualnerd.com/viewtutorial/PreAlg_02_02_0001

Super- Powers	Superpower	A country that is able to have influence globally
	Political	Related to the government
	Cultural	The way of life or traditions of a country or group of people

HISTORY – Learn the following key words

The Second World War and the Holocaust	Rationing	A system where food and supplies were limited because of shortages during the war. People had ration cards to buy only small amounts of certain goods like sugar or butter.
	Berlin Blockade	This was when the Soviet Union blocked all the roads and railways into West Berlin in 1948. They tried to cut off food and supplies to make the Allies give up control of the city.
	Cold War	A long period of tension after World War II between the USA and its allies, and the Soviet Union and its allies. They never directly fought each other, but there was a lot of spying and competition, like in the Berlin Blockade.
